Due to this programme implementation in the Taluka, Human Development Index will be increases. Hens Government Resolution MVM-2010/P.K.81/KA1418, Mantralaya Mumbai, Date 19th July 2011. As per improve the Human Development Index in identified 125 backward blocks in 22 districts.

As per Government Resolution MVM-2012/P.K.69/KA1418, Mantralaya Mumbai, Date 12th July 2012 Human Development Prgoramme Implementation and the benefits will be get many people, as per aim this programme since Year 2012-13 identified 125 Talukas 43 C-cadre Nagarpalika included.

Following 22 Districts are identified districts are as Thane, Raigad, Sindhudurg, Nashik, Dhule, Nandurbar, Jalgaon, Jalna, Parbhani, Hingoli, Beed, Nanded, Buldhana, Akola, Washim, Amaravati, Yeotmal, Nagpur, Bhandara, Gondia, Chandrapur & Gadchiroli.

Services Provided by Health Department

- 1) Examination & Treatment of pregnant women by Obs-gynec Specialists for 4 consecutive months. Treating high-risk mothers so as enable them to safe delivery & healthy neonate.
 - Counseling and medical check- up of pregnant mothers and lactating mothers.
 - Counseling pregnant mothers for nutrition & care in pregnancy.
 - Counseling lactating mothers for contraception, prevention of infection, exclusive breast feeding & weaning practices.
 - Examination & Treatment of 0-6 month infant by Pediatrics Specialist for consecutive 6 months so as to prevent infection and malnutrition.

- 2) Payment of Rs. 800/- to pregnant mothers (SC/ST/BPL) in the 9th month in favor of loss of wages. (Excluding Bhandara & Amravati)
- 3) Training adolescent girls (12-18yrs) in context with adolescence health and life skills. (Excluding Gondia, Gadchiroli, Nashik, Amravati, Nanded, Beed, Nagpur, Buldhana)
